Through **Ikuméni**, young Christians from Latin America, each one from their own identity, are protagonists of an experience of fraternity, based on the recognition of others, the encounter and hospitality.

You will be able to interact with young people from different Christian denominations, religious traditions and/or beliefs and learn about the dynamics of inter-church and inter-religious cooperation.

You will be able to contribute designing good interfaith and ecumenical practices for sustainable development and peace building in your community.

You will receive experiential, spiritual and community training, aimed at participatory and community leadership.

**Ikuméni** is aimed at young Christians who want to develop community leadership in the service of the common good.

New leaders wanting to cooperate together are needed –Christians from different churches, faithful from different religious traditions and beliefs, and people of good will– to build a life of dignity and to open new paths of hope and peace.

For 14 weeks, young Christians aged 18 to 35 will be trained to promote good ecumenical and interfaith practices in their communities.

If you are committed to your church, community, ecumenical and/or interfaith organization, **Ikuméni** is for you.



# BY IMPLEMENTING ECUMENICAL AND INTERRELIGIOUS GOOD PRACTICES

Finally and in order to get the **Ikuméni** certificate of approval, you must submit your Good Practice design proposal, which will be corrected by the tutors and approved by the **Ikuméni** professors.

The Good Practice is a final work that is carried out individually, simultaneously and in parallel to the development of the training itinerary. The tutors and mentors will accompany you in the design process.

It is any action and/or initiative in which religious actors from different Christian denominations, religious traditions and/or beliefs participate, interacting together in a process of cooperation in their city and/or local community. Together, they face the wounds generated by existing social problems in a defined territory through their contribution to Humanitarian Affairs, Sustainable Development and Peace Building, in the hope of giving a transformative response, applying the community leadership skills learned, both in its design and implementation.
